


U.S. power producers' coal consumption in first half of year million short tons




U.S. power producers' net generation from coal, 1973-2018 million kilowatthours, monthly and 12-month average



Power producers' net generation from natural gas, 1973-2018 million kilowatthours, monthly and 12-month average





Cost of coal and natural gas received at U.S. electric generating plants (US\$/mmBtu)






