

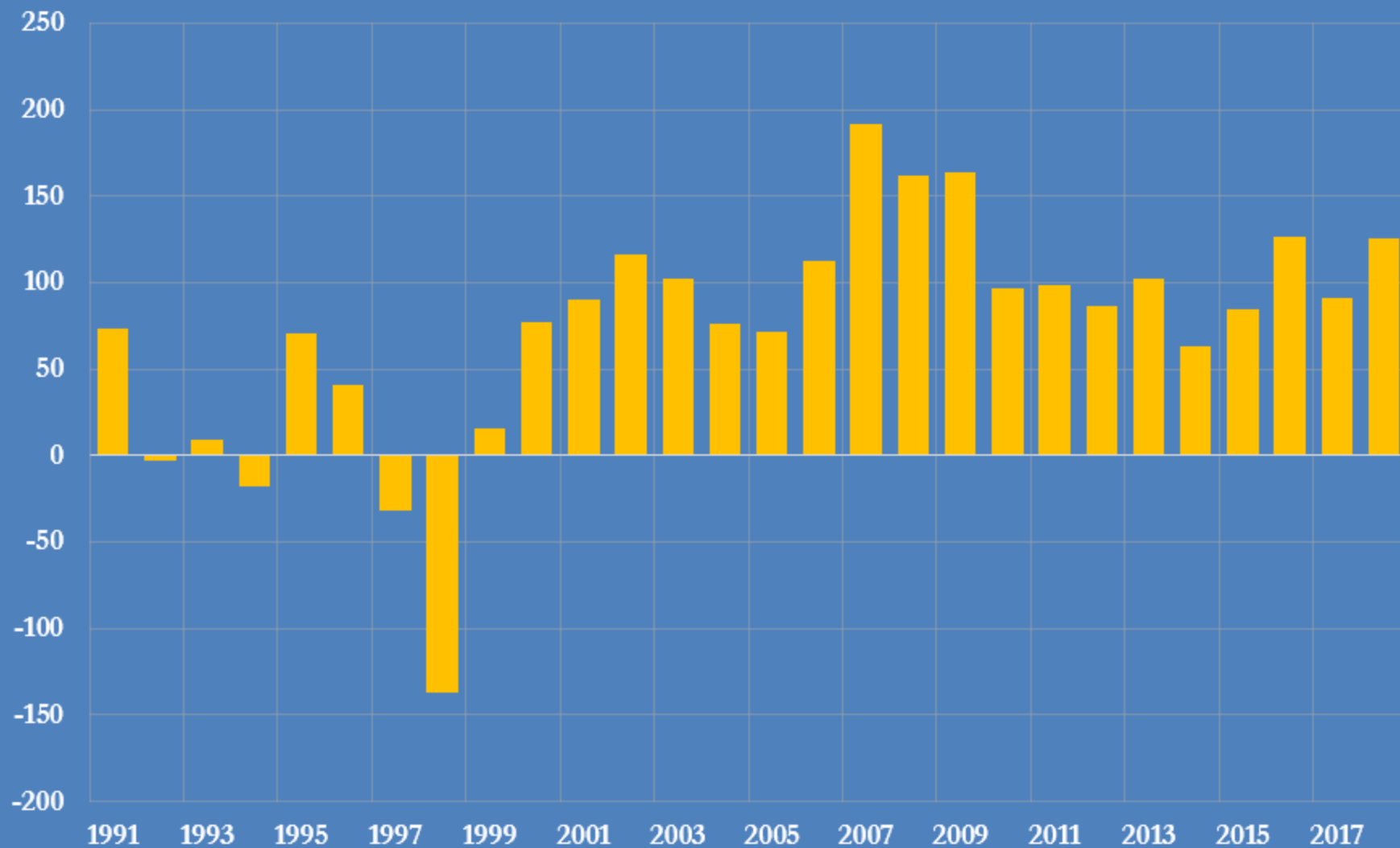

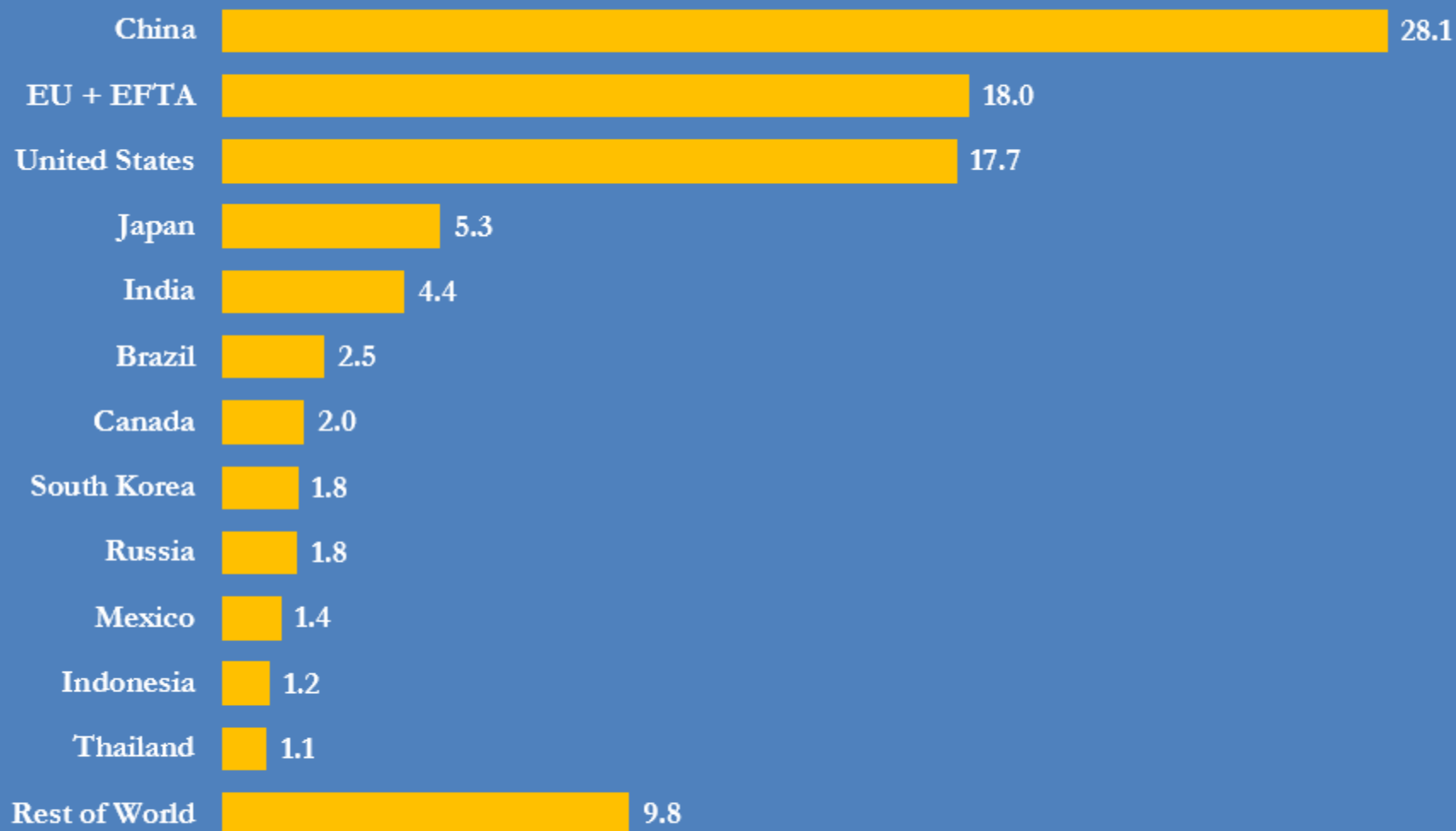

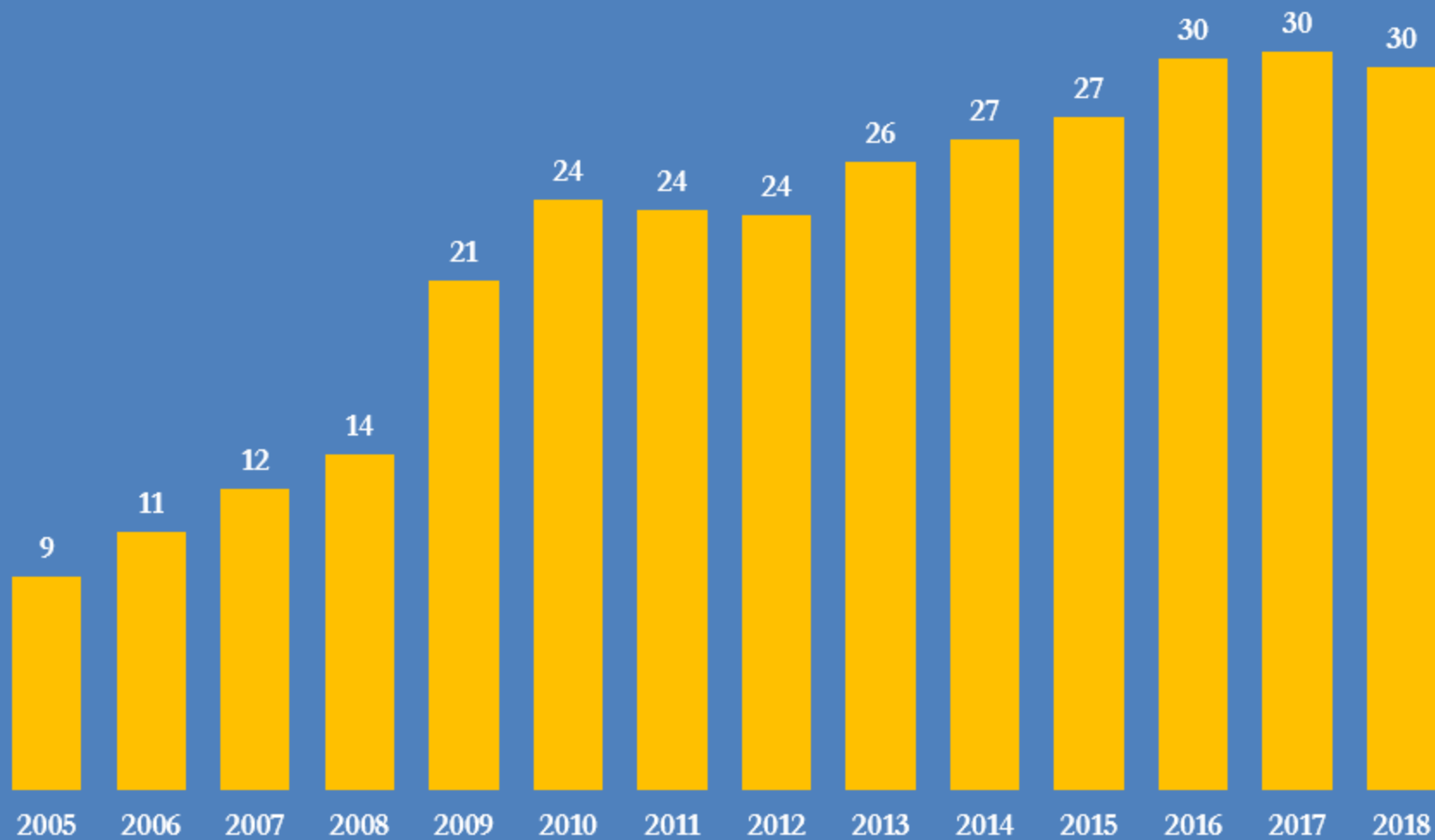
Registrations or sales of new vehicles, 2018 millions

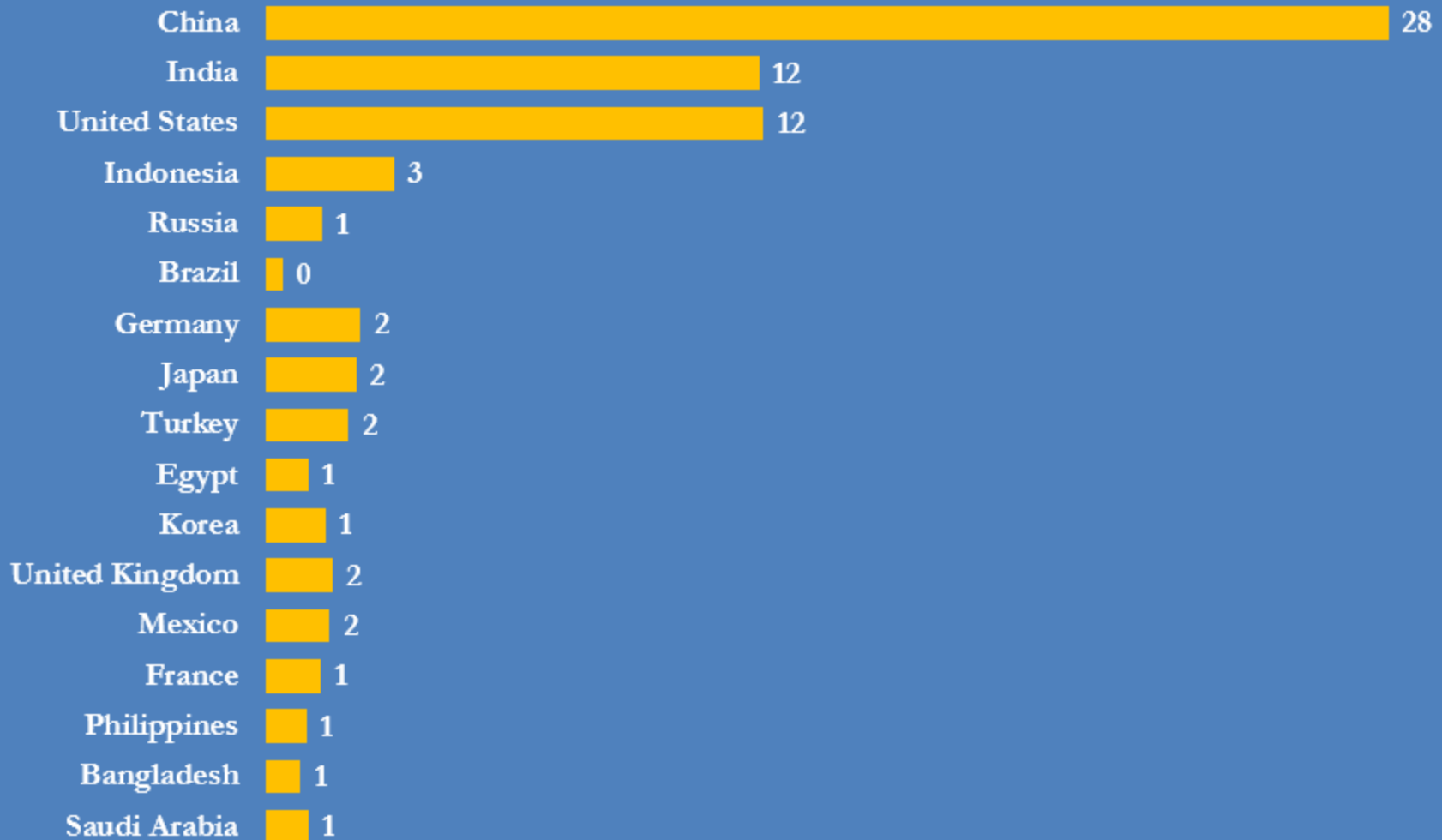
China's percent share of global new vehicle registrations and sales, 2005-2018

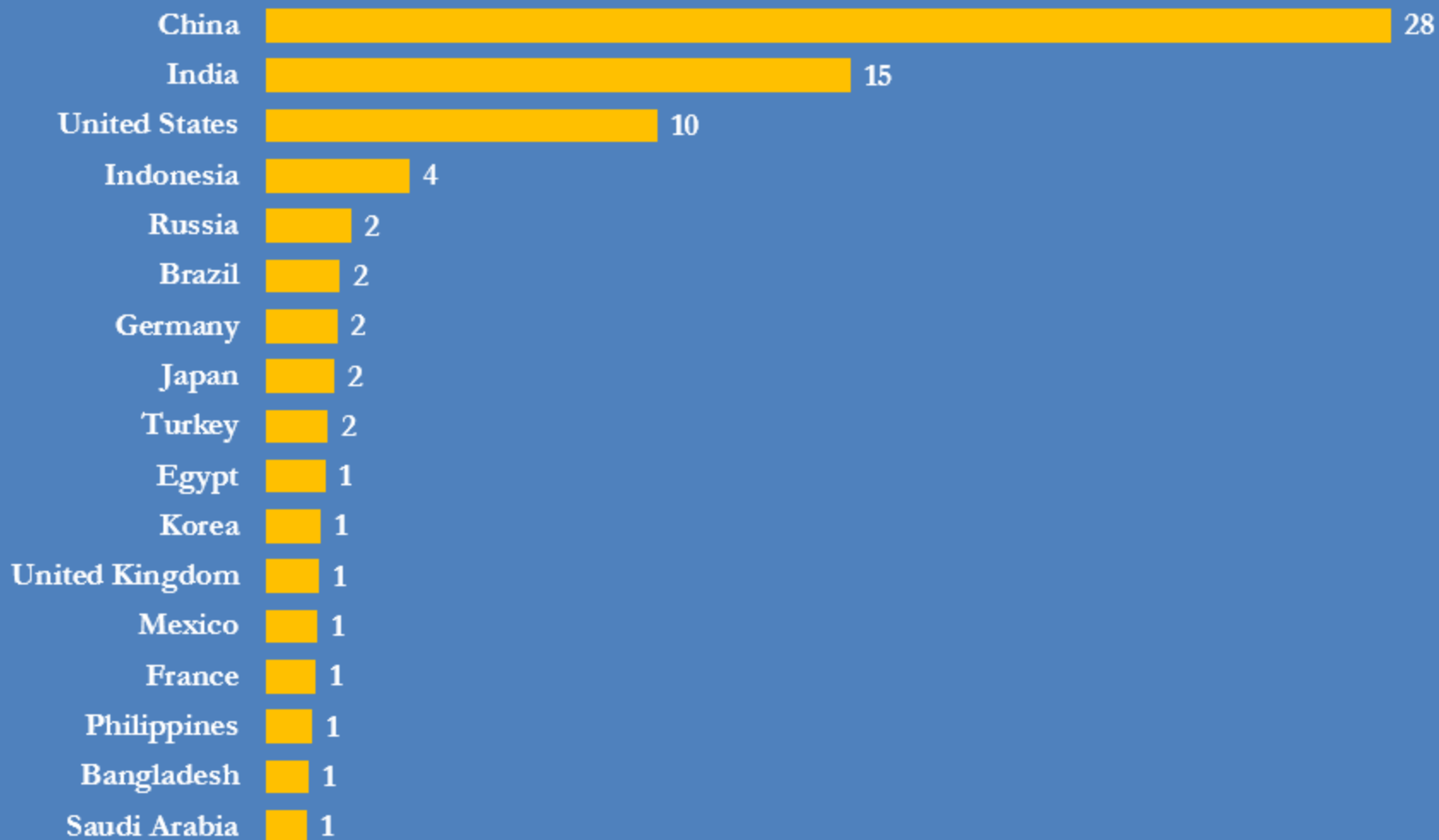
Contribution to global output growth, 2013-2018 percent of world total growth during the period GDP at purchasing power parity

Contribution to forecast global output growth, 2019-2024 percent of world total growth during the period GDP at purchasing power parity

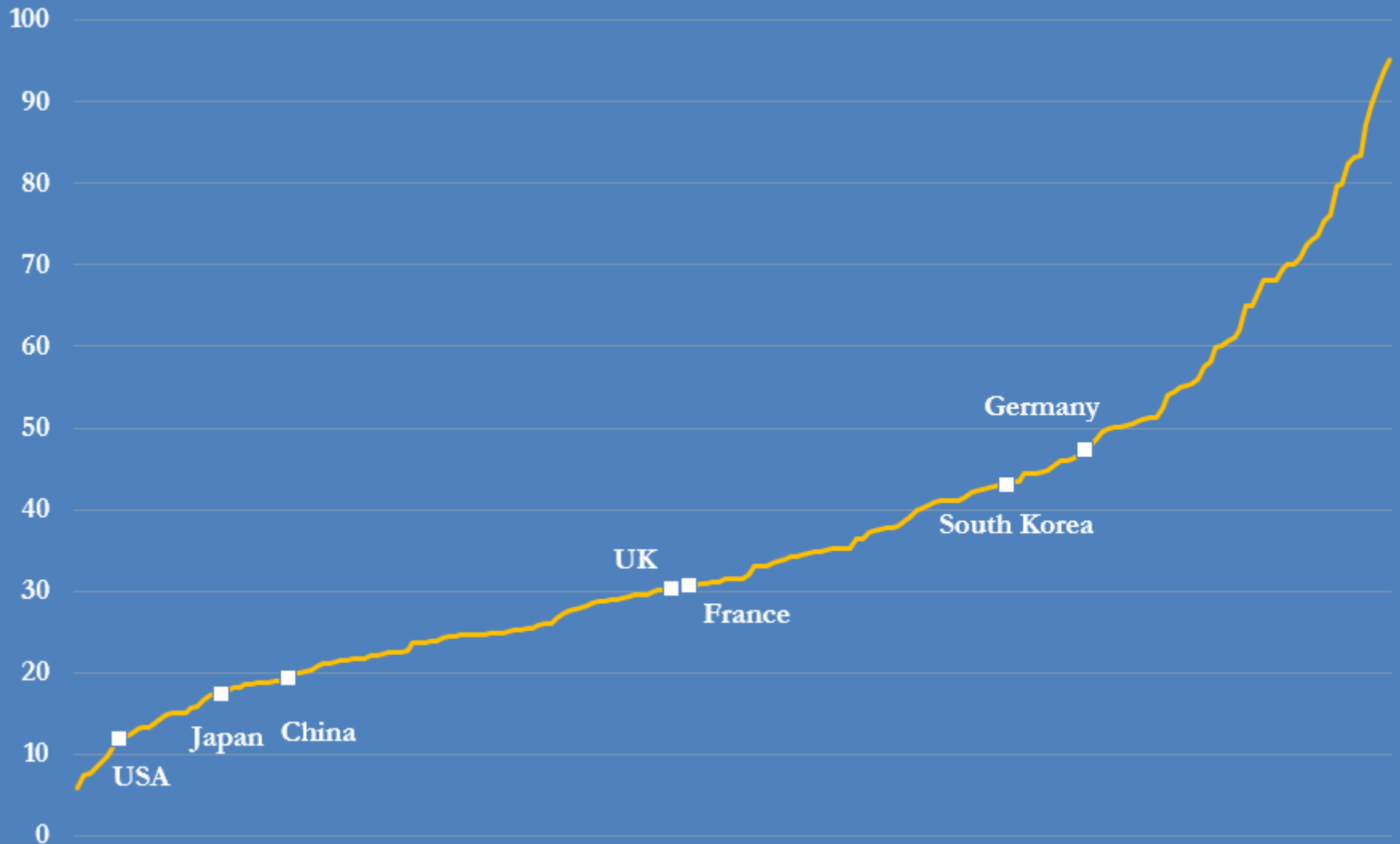
