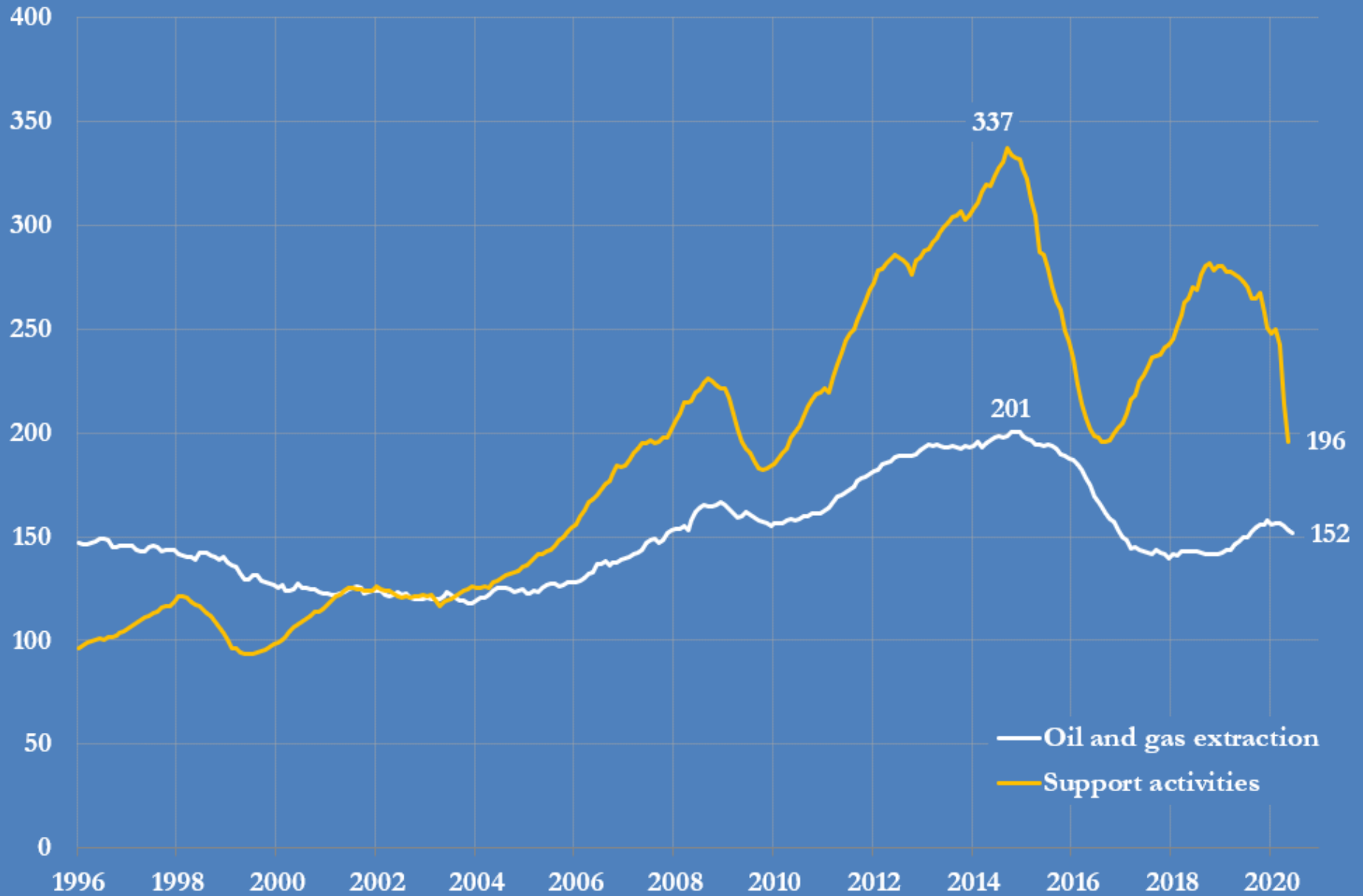

# U.S. employment in oil and gas extraction and support activities (000 payroll jobs)

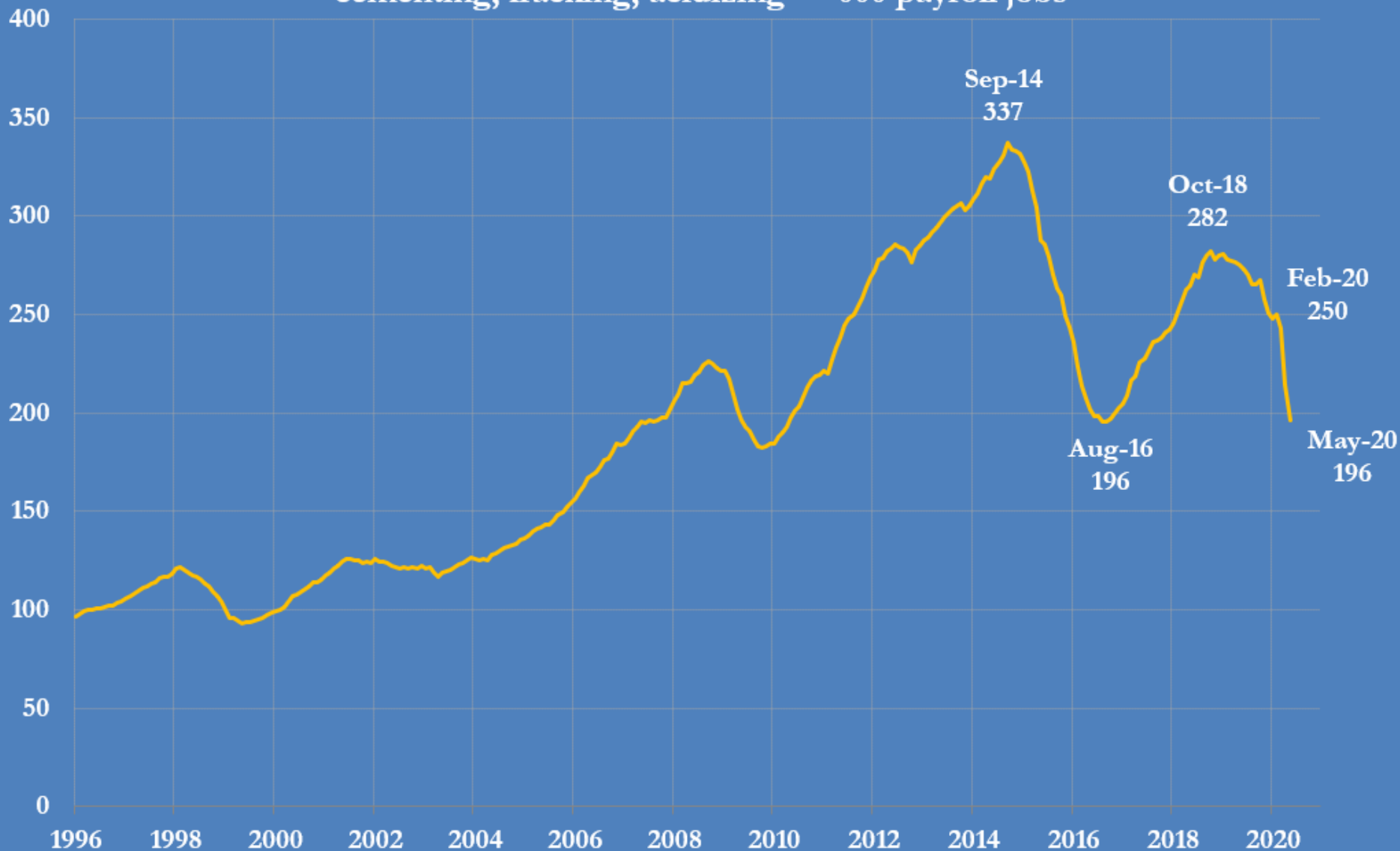

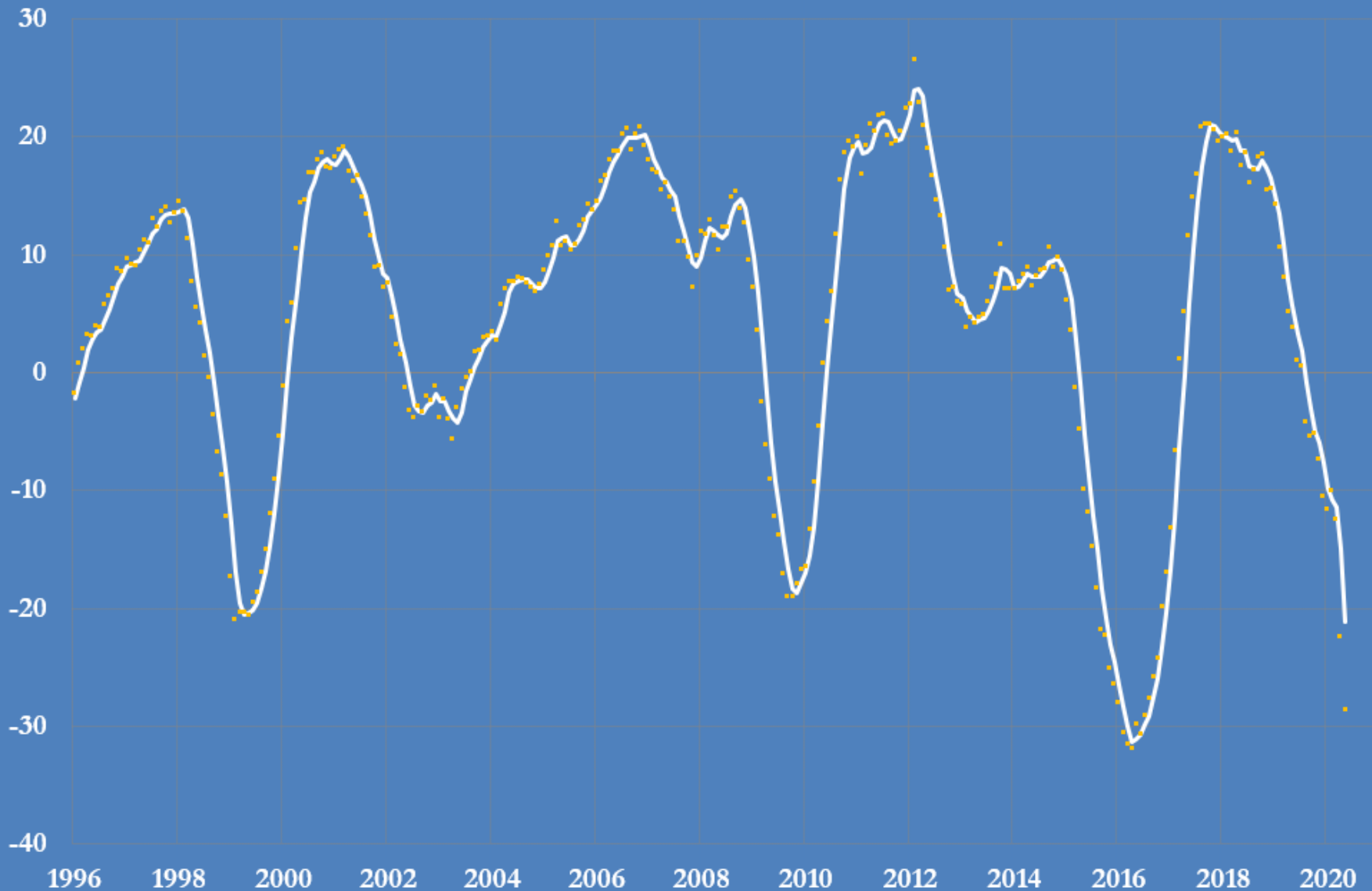
# U.S. employment in oil and gas support activities, 1996-2020

percent change from prior year, monthly and three-month average

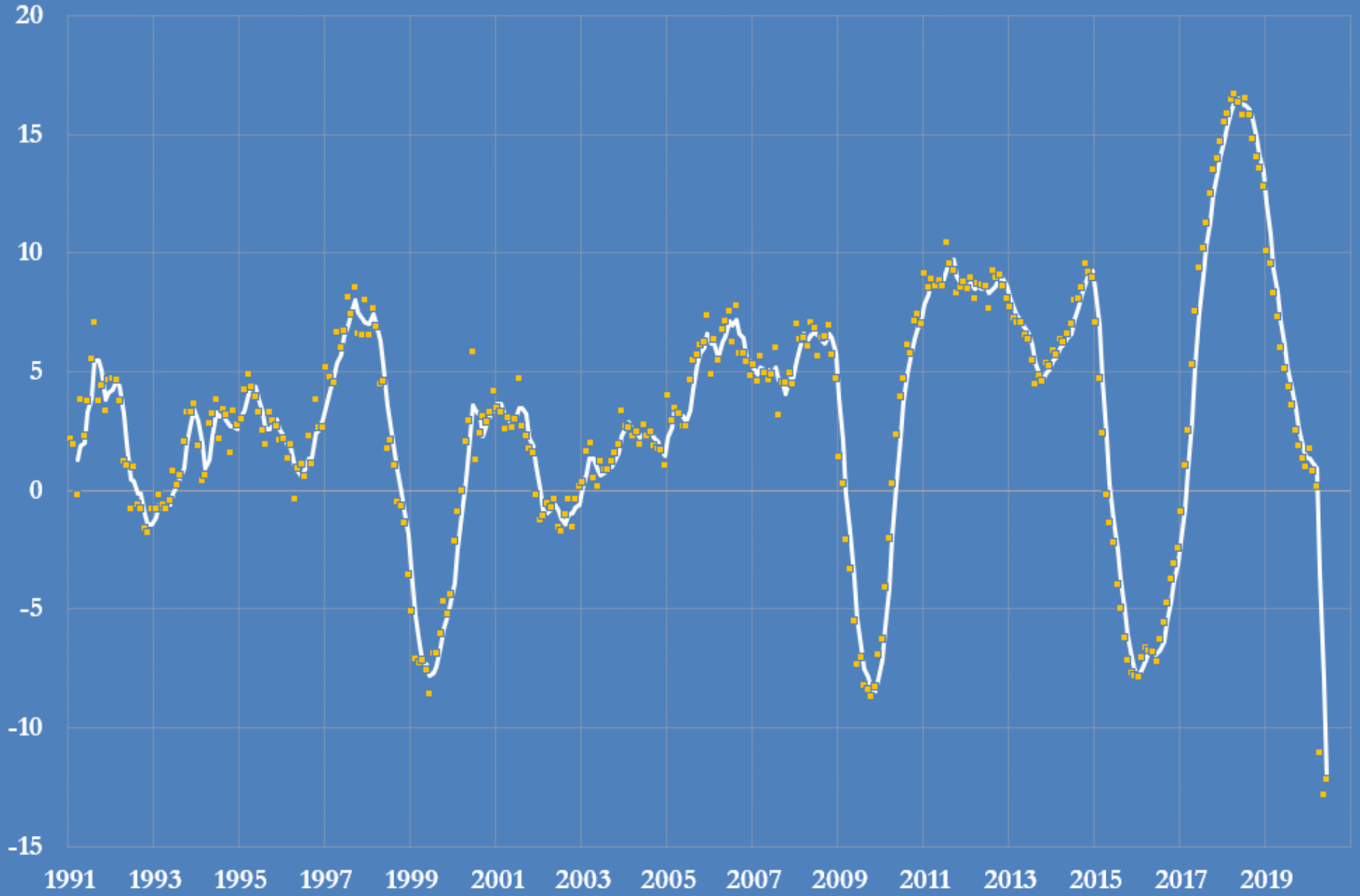

# Nonfarm employment in Midland, Texas metro-area, 1991-2020

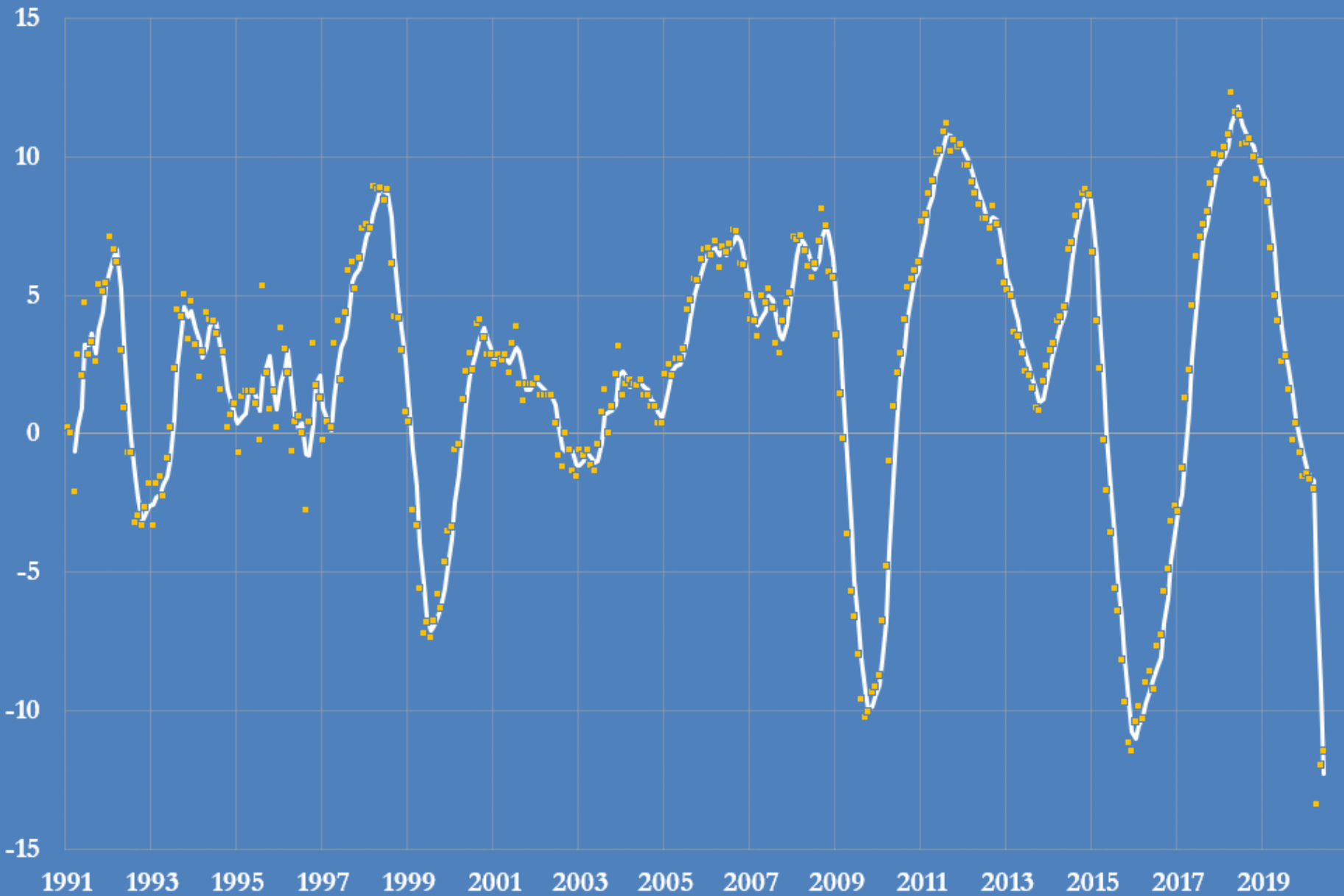
## percent change from prior year, monthly and three-month average

# Nonfarm employment in Odessa, Texas metro-area, 1991-2020 percent change from prior year, monthly and three-month average

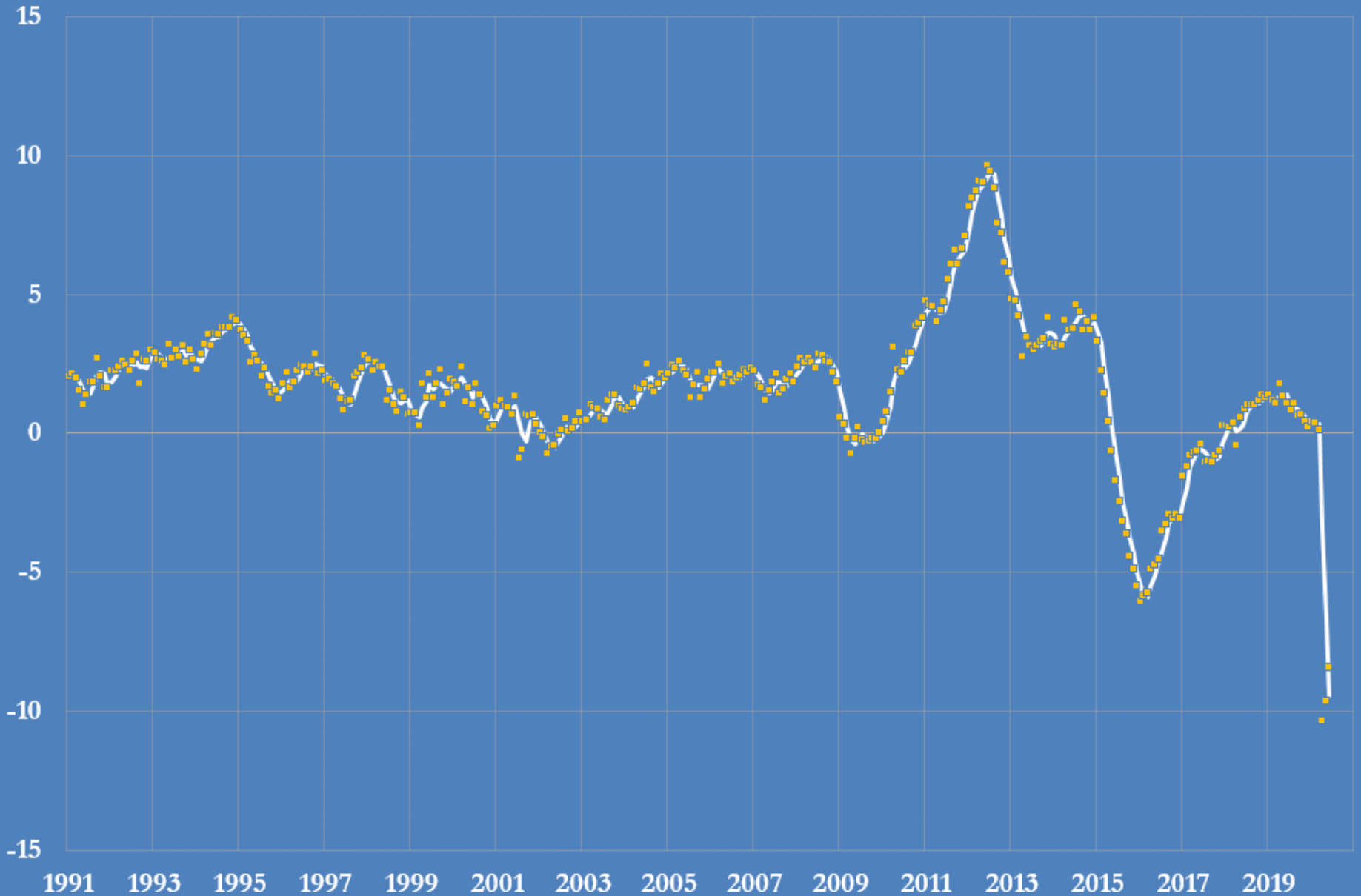

# Nonfarm employment in North Dakota, 1991-2020

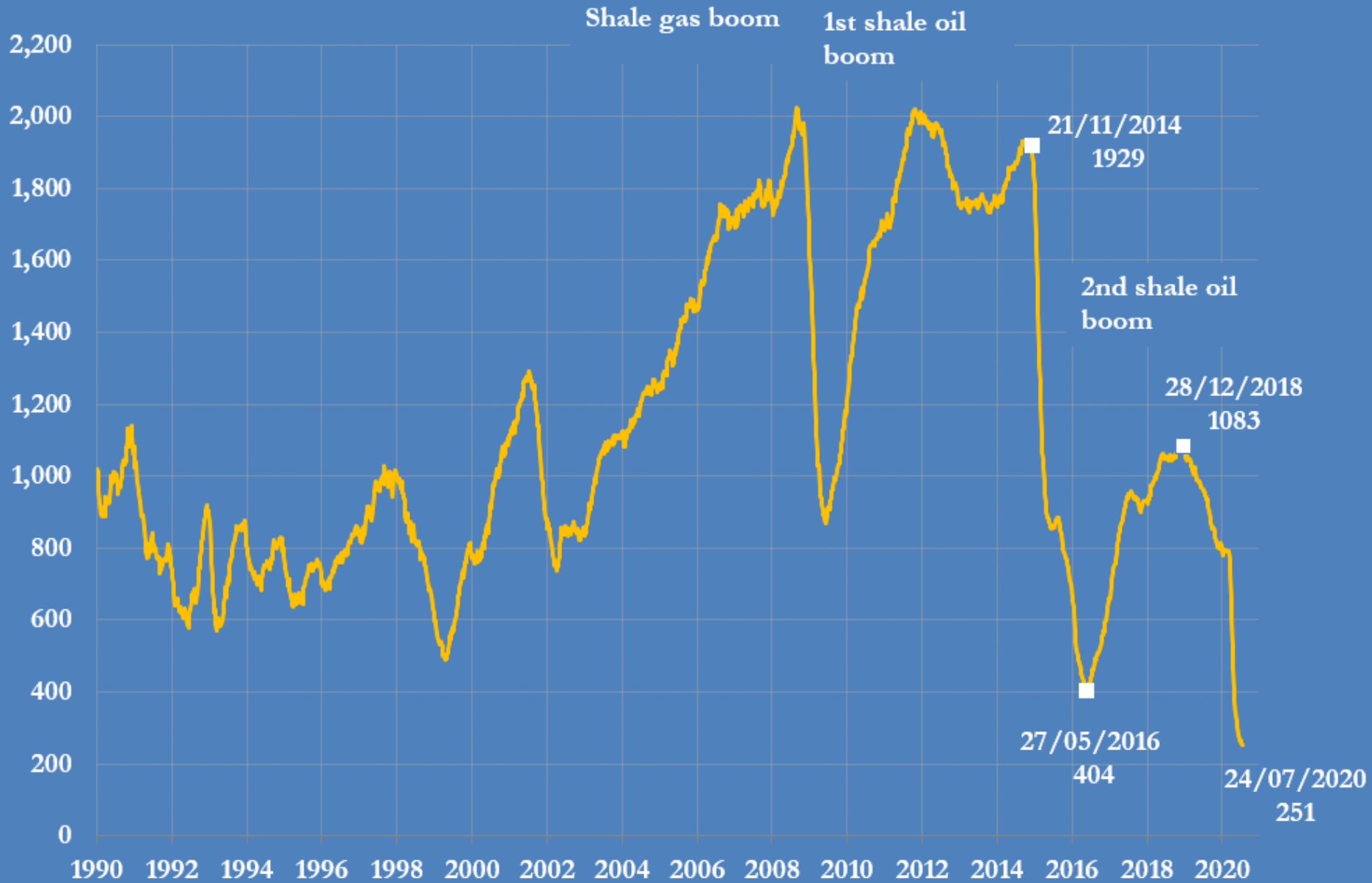
percent change from prior year, monthly and three-month average

# Rigs drilling for oil and gas in the United States, 1990-2020

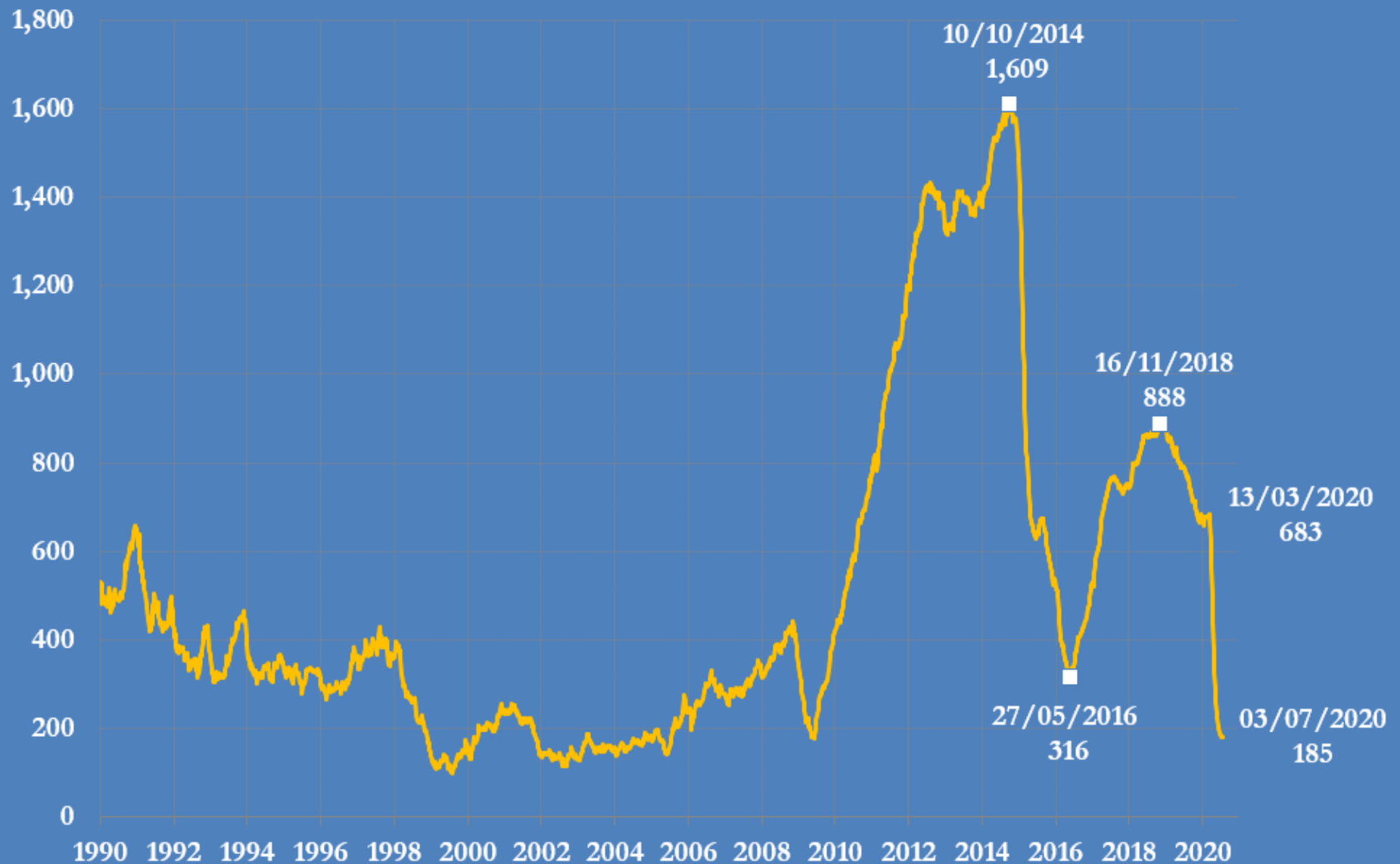
